

**Grammar****Adverbial Clause of Time**

1. Before he went to bed, he brushed his teeth.
2. As soon as he brushed his teeth, he went to bed.
3. He went to bed after he brushed his teeth.
4. He was brushing his teeth when his mother called.
5. While he was brushing his teeth, his mother called.
6. He played football until he was exhausted.

**Forms:**

Action1 + <b>before/as soon as</b> + Action2	<b>OR</b>	<b>Before/As soon as</b> + Action2 + , + Action1
Action2 + <b>when</b> + Action1	<b>OR</b>	<b>When</b> + Action1 + , + Action2
Action2 + <b>after</b> + Action1	<b>OR</b>	<b>After</b> + Action1 + , + Action2
Action1 + <b>until/till</b> + Action2	<b>OR</b>	<b>Until/Till</b> + Action2 + , + Action1
Action1 + <b>while</b> + Action1	<b>OR</b>	<b>While</b> + Action1 + , + Action1

**Examples:**

- He brushed his teeth **before** he went to bed.  
**Before** he went to bed, he brushed his teeth.
- **Until** he broke his leg, he had played football every day.  
 He had played football every day **until** he broke his leg.

**Use:**

1. “**When/while**” are used to talk about two actions which happen at the same time.
2. “**Until/till**” are used to talk about an action that continued to a specific point in time, and then stopped.
3. “**Before**” is used to talk about an action 1 that happened sometime before the second action 2, but we're not sure exactly when.
4. “**After**” is used to talk about an action 1 that happened sometime after the second action 2
5. “**As soon as**” tells us that Action1 happened immediately before Action2.

**Meaning:**

1. **Before:** មុនពេល
2. **After:** បន្ទាប់ពី
3. **When:** នៅពេល
4. **While:** ខណៈពេល
5. **Until/till:** រហូតដល់
6. **As soon as:** ភ្លាមៗនោះ
