EVEN IF Speculation or when we don't consider something as a fact or real.

"I will never marry you, even if you could walk in the sun"
(not a fact, an impossible condition)

EVEN THOUGH Two contradicting or opposing facts.

"I am eating ice cream even though we have a cold day"
(eating ice cream on a cold day is madness, so it's a contradiction but real)

AS LONG AS Action + condition.

"You can be my friend as long as you behave"
(She will stop being your friend if you don't behave in a correct way around her)
