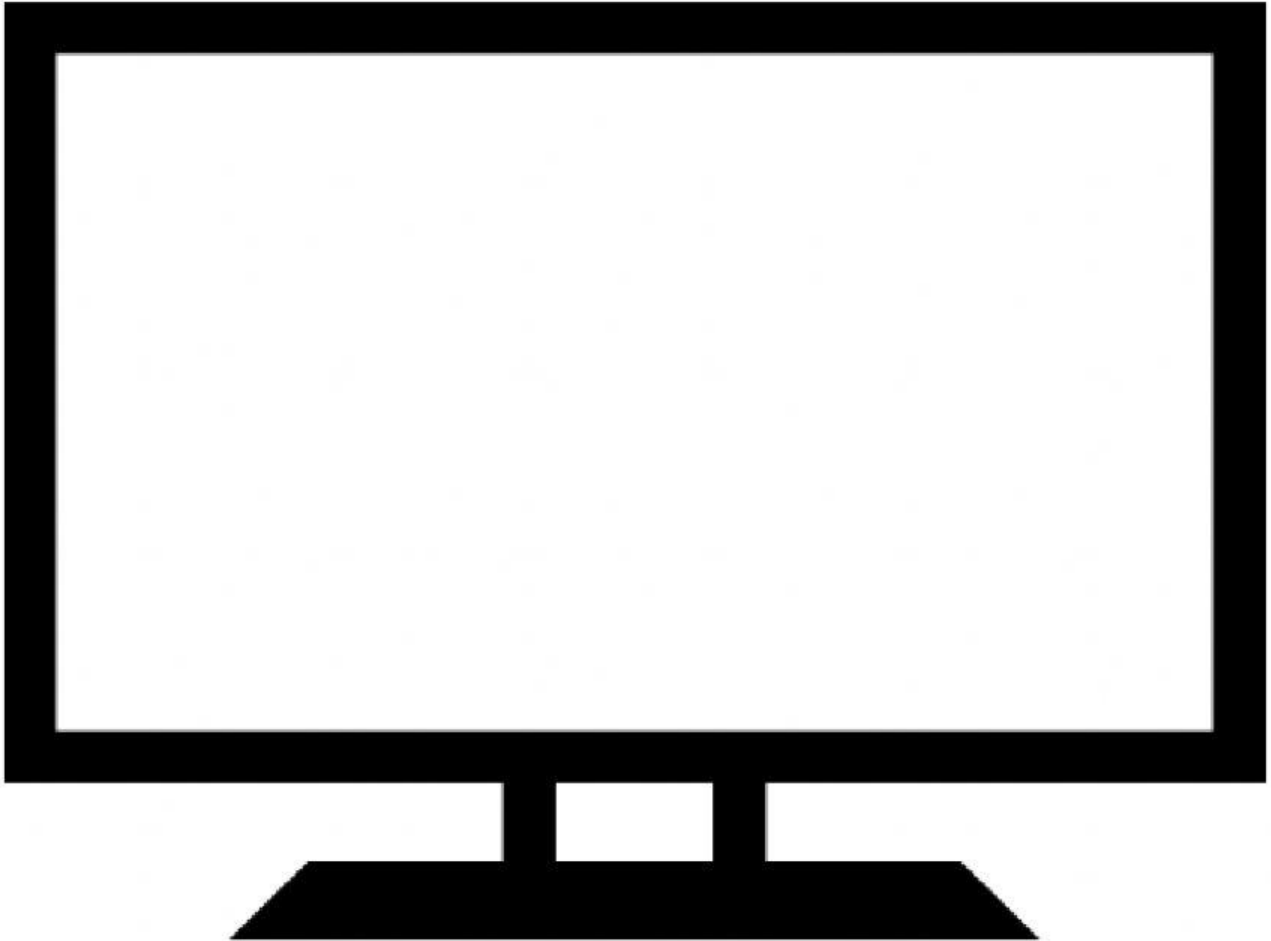


IDIOMS
