I / He / She <b>was playing</b> football when it <b>started</b> to rain.	I / He / She <b>wasn't playing</b> football when it <b>started</b> to rain.	<b>Was</b> I / he / she <b>playing</b> football when it <b>started</b> to rain?
You / We / They <b>were talking</b> when the bus <b>arrived</b> .	You / We / They <b>weren't talking</b> when the bus <b>arrived</b> .	<b>Were</b> you / we / they <b>talking</b> when the bus <b>arrived</b> ?

**3. Write sentences in PAST SIMPLE or PAST CONTINUOUS.**

Remember:

- *PAST SIMPLE: finished action in the past; in some cases this action interrupts another one.*
- *PAST CONTINUOUS (was/were + verb-ing): an action that was happening in the past, a long action.*

**Example:**

we / walk up the hill / when I / fall over

*We were walking up the hill when I fell over.*
