
POSSESSIVE CASE

That's the way to express that someone owns something.

With **persons and animals**:

Singular: **'s**

This is Tom**'s** bike.

This is Kathy**'s** mother.

Plural: **'s'**

These are the boys**'** bikes.

This is the girls**'** mum.

With **things**: **of**

The colour **of** the table is black.

The second chapter **of** this book.

If the noun **ends with an s**, add just the apostrophe to the end of the noun.

Where is Jess**'** school bag?

If there are two nouns, change only the last one to the possessive.

Sam and Cathy**'s** new dog is really cute.
