

POSSESSIVE CASE

That's the way to express that someone owns something.

With **persons and animals**:

Singular: **'s**

This is Tom's bike.

This is Kathy's mother.

Plural: **s'**

These are the boys' bikes.

This is the girls' mum.

With **things**: **of**

The colour **of** the table is black.

The second chapter **of** this book.

If the noun **ends with an s**, add just the apostrophe to the end of the noun.

Where is Jess' school bag?

If there are two nouns, change only the last one to the possessive.

Sam and Cathy's new dog is really cute.
