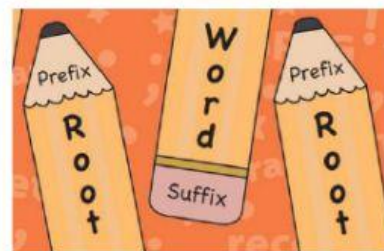


## Test your grammar skills
