


Reading Comprehension: ANIMALS

<p>Grey wolves live in the open woods and hills of North America, Asia, and some parts of Europe. They don't usually live alone. They move about in numbers of between two and six. A wolf often lives to about seven or eight years old.</p> <p>Grey wolves are a grey-brown colour on their bodies with white near their mouths. They have thick coats because they live in cold countries.</p> <p>An older wolf can weigh between 23 and 60 kilograms, and it can be up to one and a half metres long. Wolves can also run very fast. Some wolves can run over 60 kilometres an hour.</p> <p>Wolves eat different things. They run after and kill bigger animals like deer, but they eat little animals like</p>	<p>mice, too. In the warmer months, they take fruit from trees.</p> <p>Some people are afraid of wolves, but they aren't usually dangerous. They don't attack people, and they like to live away from towns and villages.</p>
