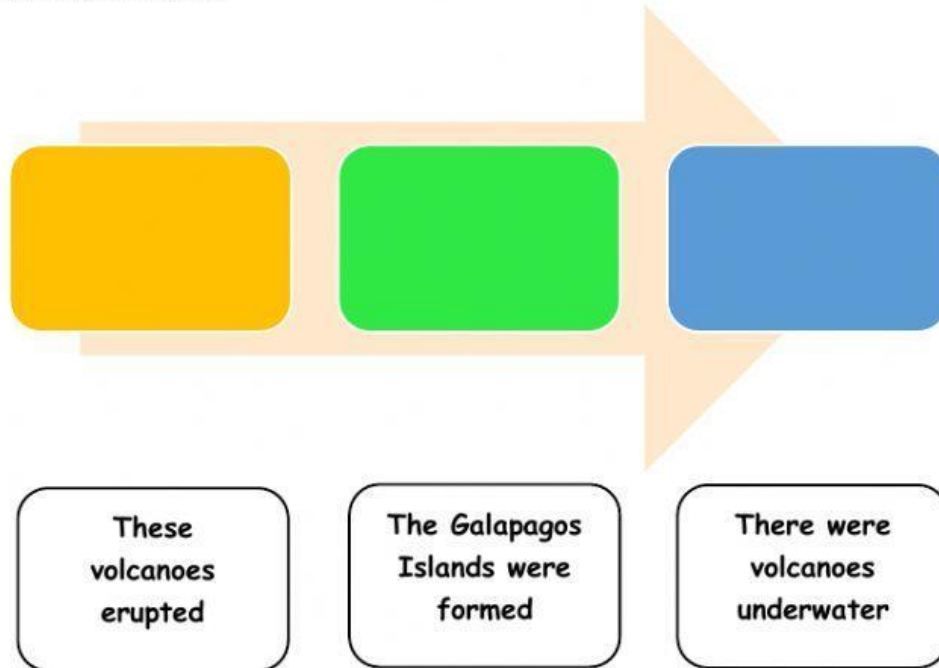

With the exception of San Cristóbal Island, on which the Junco lagoon is found, there are almost no natural water sources for agricultural or domestic use. So, how can a water supply be guaranteed, and at the same time maintain the integrity of the natural ecosystems and the health of the population?"
