Affirmative and negative

SUBJECT	+VERB TO BE	+REST
I	<i>was</i>	at school, yesterday
We	<i>were</i>	at school, yesterday

SUBJECT	+VERB TO BE	
	AFFIRMATIVE	NEGATIVE
I / he / she / it	<i>was</i>	<i>wasn't</i>
we / you / they	<i>were</i>	<i>weren't</i>

Interrogative and short answers

+VERB TO BE	SUBJECT	+REST
<i>was</i>	I	at school, yesterday?
<i>were</i>	We	at school, yesterday?

Short answers	
Affirmative	negative
Yes, I/he/she/it <i>was</i> .	No, I/he/she/it <i>wasn't</i> .
Yes, we / you/they <i>were</i> .	No, we/you/they <i>weren't</i> .

Information questions with was / were

Question word	WAS / WERE
When	were you in hospital?
Why	was he late?
Where	were they last night?
How	was the party?
How old	was she in 2004?

PAST SIMPLE REGULAR VERBS

Affirmative

SUBJECT	+VERB	+REST
I/he/she/it/we/you/they	watch ed	a movie last night.

- La mayoría de los verbos agregan **ED** al final:
 watch - watch**ED** play - play**ED**
- Los verbos base terminados en **-e** agregan **D** al final:
 live - live**D** like - like**D**
- Los verbos terminados en **CONSONANTE+y**, eliminan la "y" y agregan **IED** al final:

carry - carr**IED** worry - worr**IED**

IRREGULAR VERBS

Irregular verbs do not follow a pattern.

You need to learn them.

I go to the cinema every night.

→ I **went** to the cinema last night.

read /ri:d/	read /red/
ride	rode
run	ran

see	saw
speak	spoke
spend	spent
take	took
win	won
write	wrote

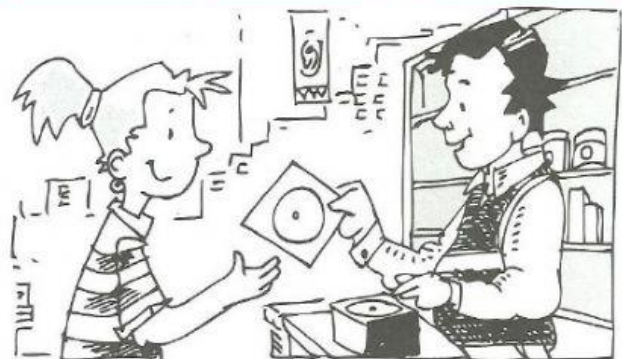
