We use....

Present continuous

* to talk about future intentions or plans. We use it for plans when we haven't decided all the details yet.

Be going to + inf

* to make predictions about the future. These predictions are based on our opinion so we usually use 'I think' or 'I don't think' with it.

Will / Won't + inf

* to talk or ask about fixed arrangements, especially when we say when/ where or who with.
