THE PASSIVE VOICE

TENSE	ACTIVE VOICE	PASSIVE VOICE
Present simple	He receives a letter.	A letter is <input type="text"/> by him.
Present continuous	He is <input type="text"/> a letter.	A letter is being received by him.
Past simple	He received a letter.	A letter <input type="text"/> received by him.
<input type="text"/> continuous	He was receiving a letter.	A letter was being received by him.
Present perfect	He <input type="text"/> received a letter.	A letter has been received by him.
Past perfect	He <input type="text"/> received a letter.	A letter had been received by him.
Future simple	He <input type="text"/> receive a letter.	A letter will be received by him.
Going to	He is going <input type="text"/> receive a letter.	A letter is going to be received by him.
Infinitive	He has to <input type="text"/> a letter.	A letter has to be received by him.
Modals	He should receive a letter.	A letter should be <input type="text"/> by him.
