







Using Question Words

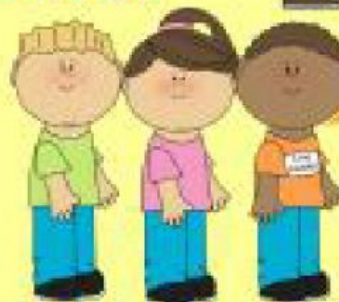
