IT IS MIDNIGHT **NOW** AND BRIAN DOESN'T GO/ ISN'T GOING TO BED BECAUSE TOMORROW IS SUNDAY AND HE ISN'T WAKING UP/ DOESN'T WAKE UP EARLY.
