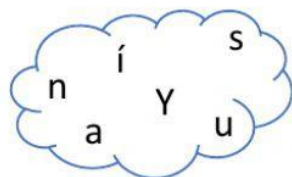
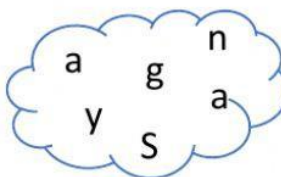
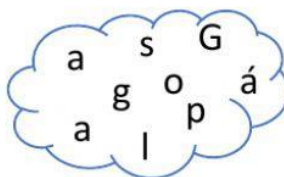
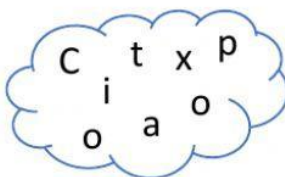


It is the name given to collective animal life that lives or was once found in a certain area or time period.
