The simple present tense is made with either the bare form or the present singular form.

I / you / we / they / plural noun	bare infinitive
he / she / it / singular noun	present singular

I **love** gardening.

Mr Gurung **loves** gardening.

The negative form is **don't** / **doesn't** + bare form.

They **don't** love gardening.

She **doesn't** love gardening.

The question is formed with **do/does**.

Do you love gardening?

Does he love gardening?

Why **does** he love gardening?
