4. A group of people singing together: **lead singer** – **choir** - **chorus**
5. A person that sings: **lyrics** – **hit** - **singer**
6. The words of a song —often used in plural: **concert**- **lyrics** - **conductor**
7. A long musical recording on a record, CD, etc., that usually includes a set of songs: **composer**- **hit** - **album**
8. The main singer or vocalist: **live performance**- **conductor** – **lead singer**
9. The musical notes of a song or piece of music: **hit** – **melody** - **stage**
10. A person who writes music: **composer** – **singer** - **conductor**
11. A public performance of music: **album** – **hit** - **concert**
12. A raised platform in a theater, auditorium, etc., where the performers stand: **chorus** – **stage** - **hit**
13. A group of musicians who play usually classical music together and who are led by a conductor: **choir** – **album** - **orchestra**
14. A person who stands in front of people while they sing or play musical instruments and directs their performance: **conductor** – **singer** – **composer**
15. Singing a song or acting in a play to entertain an audience on that moment (not recorded): **album** – **song**- **live performance**
