The old museum is to on Thursday.

10. Marie-Anne started to cry when she heard the news.

BURST

Marie-Anne. when she heard the news.

11. I offered to lend Phil money for the trip but he refused.

TURNED

Phil to lend him money for the trip.

12. When Jules was in Finland, he managed to learn some Finnish.

PICK

When Jules was in Finland, he was some Finnish.

13. We intend to start our journey at 10 o'clock.

OFF

We have the intention at 10 o'clock.

14. Helen and Roger ended their relationship a long time ago.

SPLIT

Helen and Roger each other a long time ago.

15. He disappointed his parents when he behaved so badly.

DOWN

His parents were his bad behaviour.
