

UNIT 11 — simple past passive

Function

We use the simple past passive to focus on the thing that received the action, when we don't know who or what did something, when it's obvious or unimportant who or what did something.

Form

Affirmative		Negative	
Auxiliary <i>was/were</i> in simple past	+ past participle of the verb	Auxiliary <i>was/were</i> in simple past + not	+ past participle of the verb
