Structure	Function
Stigma	They protect the unopened flower, especially in the bud stage.
Style	They may be brightly coloured to attract insects
Ovary	The thin stick-like structure that holds up the anther
Pollen Grains	They produce male cells called pollen grains
Ovules	The male cells of the flower
Filament	The sticky, top of the female part of the flower which collects pollen grains
Anther	The thin tube that connects the stigma to the ovary. It contains the pollen tube.
Pedicel	It contains the ovules. It turns into the fruit when the flower is fertilized.
Sepals	They contain the female cells.
Petal	It is the stem that connects the flower to the plant
