The past week was the worst that the markets have seen in more than 11 years. The *Dow Jones* lost 357 points on Friday and more than 3,500 points all week in the United States of America.

It was the largest weekly point loss ever, and the biggest loss since October 2008 during the global financial crisis.



Economic experts **blame** mostly the corona virus. They say that the corona virus is hurting businesses, shopping centres, and tourism, people can't travel abroad freely. Global markets in Japan, Italy, and Germany have all experienced similar **drops**.

There are more than 83,000 people ill in the world; most of them are in China. However, Officials say that there will probably be an increase in corona virus cases in the US. On Friday, the World Health Organization raised the global risk of the virus to its highest level. However, Trump administration officials said on Wednesday that the risk to the American public is low.
