How = Cómo

Example:

- How does Michael Phelps swim?
- o He is very quick. He swims quickly.

Quickly is an adverb of manner.



RULES TO FORM ADVERBS OF MANNER

To form adverbs of manner we use the adjectives:

ADJECTIVES	ADVERBS	Explanation
Quick	Quickly	
Slow	Slowly	
Bad	Badly	When the adjectives
Quiet	Quietly	finish in consonant,
Loud	Loudly	we add -ly
Careful	Carefully	to form the adverb.
Dangerous	Dangerously	
Sad	Sadly	
		When the adjectives
Нарру	Happily	finish in "y", this
Angry	Angrily	changes into "i". Then
Sleepy	Sleepily	we add-ly to form
		the adverb.
Good	Well	
Fast	Fast	Irregular cases.




