Linda: you any brothers or sisters?

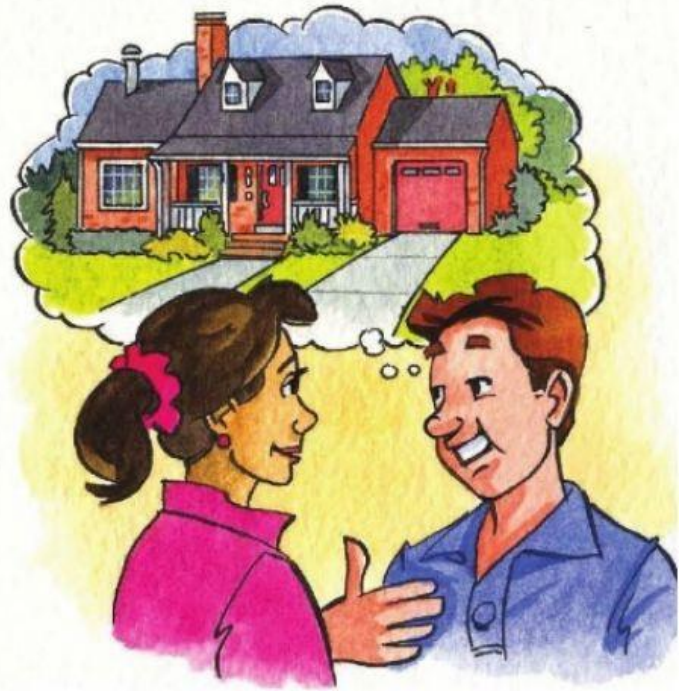
Chris: Yes, I I four sisters.
