Look at these sentences from the text. Without looking back, fill in the gaps using the correct form of the verbs in brackets.

- 1 This is surprising given that organisations invest huge amounts of money in (*develop*) packaging that they believe is effective.
- 2 This requires comparatively little effort, and involves (*look at*) – and (*think about*) – only a small amount of the product information and packaging.
- 3 Under heuristic processing, for example, consumers may simply need (*be able to*) distinguish the pack from those of competitors.
- 4 Consumers will want (*be able to*) compare the product with its competitors.
- 5 The role of packaging is likely (*be*) very different.
- 6 People vary in the extent to which they enjoy (*think*).
- 7 Prompting deeper level thinking that would include (*make*) comparisons with other products.
- 8 Conversely, getting consumers (*change*) brands may involve (*develop*) packaging that does stimulate systematic processing and thus encourages consumers (*challenge*) their usual choice of product.
