Object pronouns

(I)	----->	me
(you)	----->	you
(he)	----->	him
(she)	----->	her
(it)	----->	it
(we)	----->	us
(they)	----->	them

The subject does the action of the verb. The **subject** is **before** the verb.

The **object** receives the action of the verb. The **object** is **after** the verb.

Examples: Look at the 2 pictures. Are they the same? Who helps who?



The girl helps the boy.

She helps **him**.

She is the subject.

The **girl** is the subject.

The **boy** is the **object**.

him is the **object**



The boy helps the girl.

He helps **her**.

He is the subject.

The **boy** is the subject.
