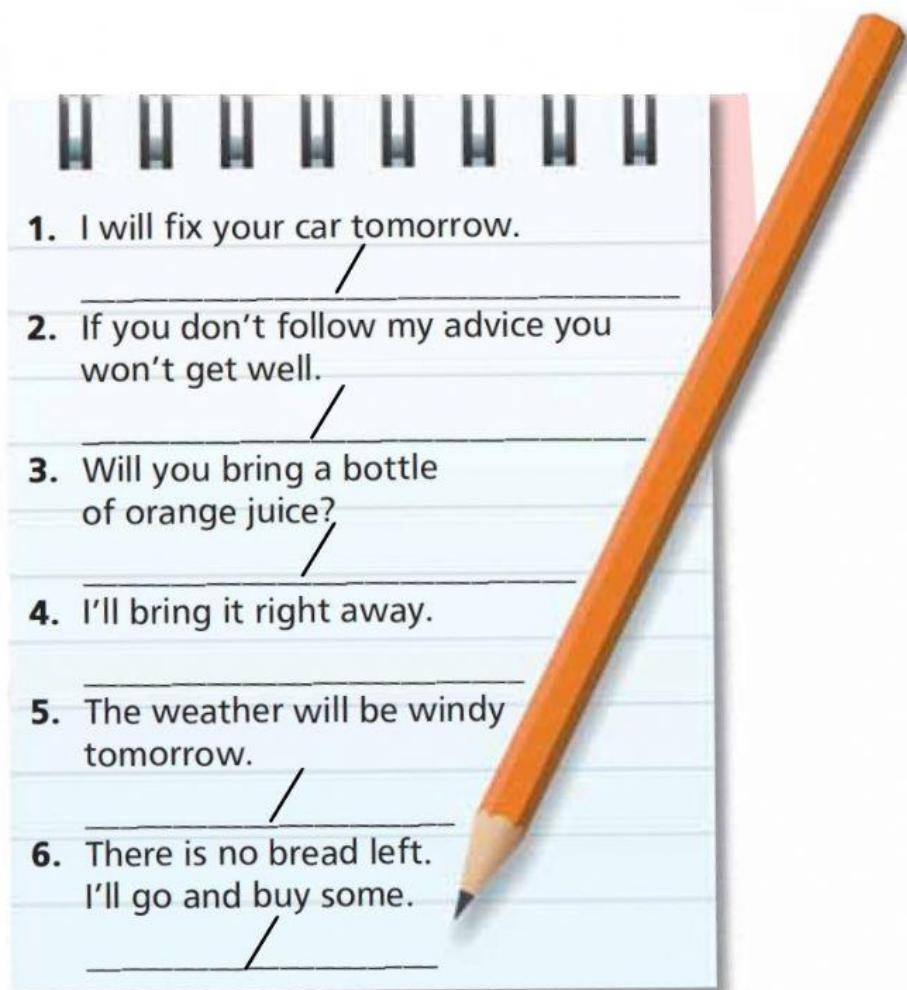


1. Look at the verbs in the following examples.
