I *did not have* breakfast yesterday.

He *didn't* come here.

◆ 의문문: Did + 주어 + 동사원형 ... ?

- Yes, 주어 + did. / No, 주어 + didn't.

Did you see him there? - Yes, I *did*/ No, I *didn't*.
