

Factors that threaten Biodiversity

Matching between the term and definition:

Overexploitation

Humans have developed land to live on or cleared ecosystems to produce crops.(Destruction or Distribution of habitat)

Habitat loss

The separation of an ecosystem into small pieces of land

Introduced Species

Change the composition of air,soil, and water(human made chemicals, Acid precipitation, Eutrophication)

Pollution

Nonnative species that are either intentionally or unintentionally transported to a new habitat.

Fragmentation of habitat

Excessive use of species that have economic value. Example: White rhinoceros: hunted for their horns
