## **AFFIXES, PREFIXES & SUFFIXES**

Remember that affixes are made up of letters that are added to the beginning or the end of a root word. Letters added to the beginning of a word are called prefixes. Letters added to the end of a word are called suffixes. By adding affixes to a root word, we change its meaning or create a new word.

## Example:

Manny helps younger suburban kids learn how to play baseball.

The *sub-* in *suburban* is a prefix that changes the meaning of the word **urban**.

The *-er* in *younger* is a suffix that shows the degree of the word *young*.

Some special cases for the -er suffix are when an adjective ends in "e," e.g. close -> closer, or when it ends in "y," when it is changed for an "i," e.g. pretty -> prettier.
