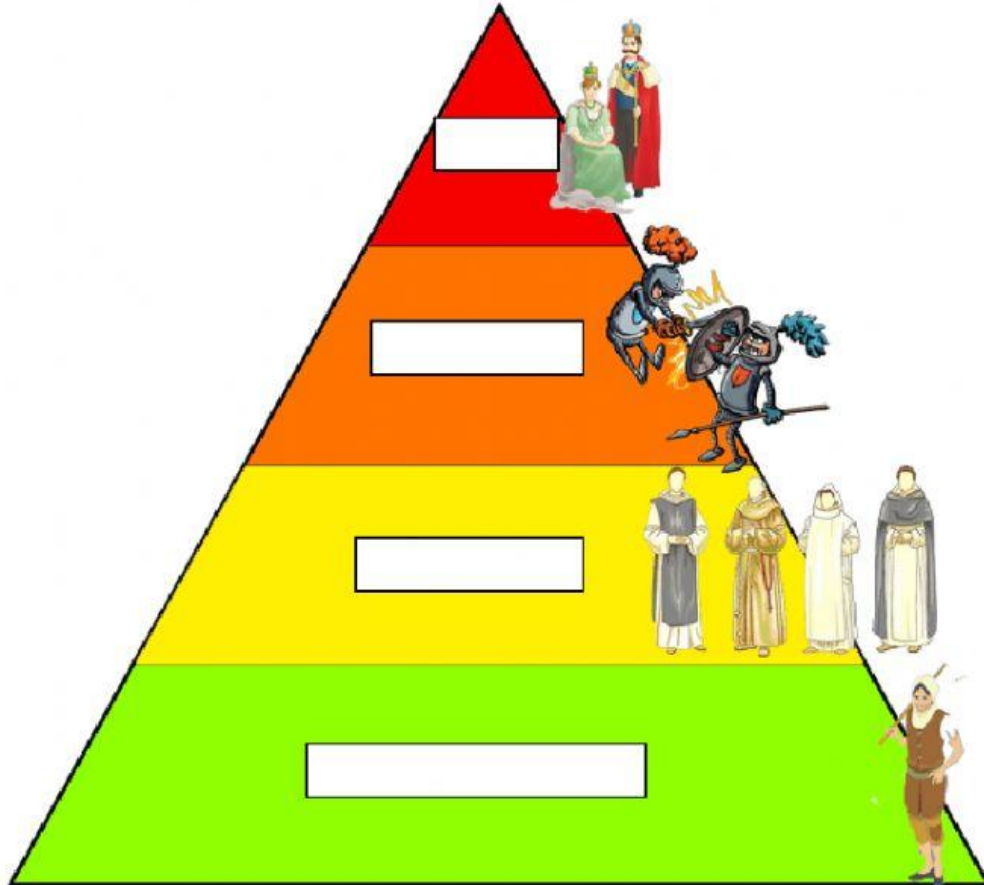


# MIDDLE AGES
