I	am	going	to the city.
You	are	reading	books.
We		playing	baseball.
They		talking	too loudly.
He	is	watching	a movie.
She		jumping	and singing.
It		walking	slowly.

We use the **Present Continuous Tense** to talk about things that are happening **right now**.

To talk about **right now**, you have to use a "Be verb" (am, is, are) and a verb + ing.
