- * Ana **goes** to school very early.

NEGATIVE

- I **don't** go to school by bike.
- They **don't** play soccer on Tuesdays.
- * Ana **doesn't** go to school late.

INTERROGATIVE

- **Do** you study at Adesa?
Yes, I **do**.

- * **Does** Ana go to school late?
- No, she doesn't.

- **Do** they play soccer at school?
Yes, they **do**.

- * **Does** the kangaroo live in the jungle?
- No, it doesn't.
