1 litre (L) = 1,000 millilitres (mL)

$\frac{1}{2}$ litre (L) = 500 millilitres (mL)

$\frac{1}{4}$ litre (L) = 250 millilitres (mL)

$\frac{3}{4}$ litre (L) = 750 millilitres (mL)

Example: $1\frac{3}{4}$ L = 1000mL + 750mL = **1750ml**
