A. Рубрика:

Revolution in air travel. Instead of hanging around in crowded air terminals, enduring hours in cramped planes, eating junk food and watching soppy movies, passengers would be able to take the option of travelling as freight! For a fraction of the fare, they can be anaesthetized at a local travel centre, transported to the airport and, while sleeping in a padded, air-conditioned casket, loaded onto a plane, whisked off to their destination and woken with a complimentary drink at the other end.
