

## SENTENCE STRUCTURE

### AFFIRMATIVE

I/you/we/they **have** worked.

He/she/it **has** worked.

### NEGATIVE

I/you/we/they **haven't** worked.

He/she/it **hasn't** worked.

### INTERROGATIVE

Have I/you/we/they worked?

**Has** he/she/it worked?

### SHORT ANSWERS

**Yes**, I/you/we/they **have**.

**No**, he/she/it **hasn't**.

## LONG AND SHORT FORMS

**I have** been to Paris.

**I've** been to Paris.

**You have not** played tennis.

**You haven't** played tennis.

### 3<sup>rd</sup> Person

**She has** been to London.

**She's** been to London.

**Peter has not** written a book.

**Peter hasn't** written a book.
