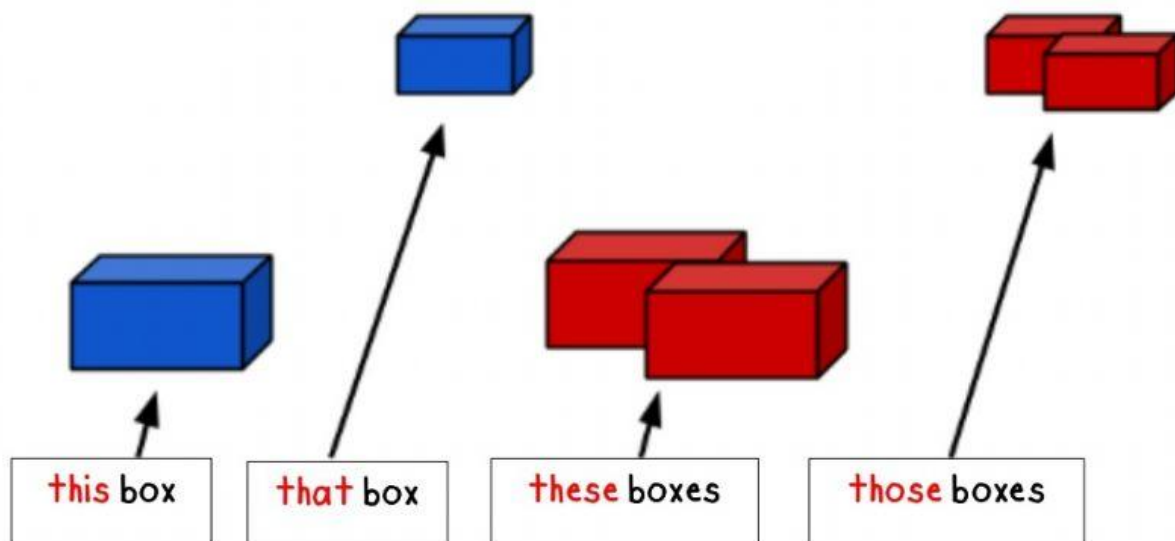


# Demonstrative Determiners

this / that / these / those

- It is used to indicate how **near** or **far** something is from us.
- We use **this** and **that** for one thing (singular), while we use **these** and **those** for two or more things (plural).
