Mrs. Jordan: Get married!

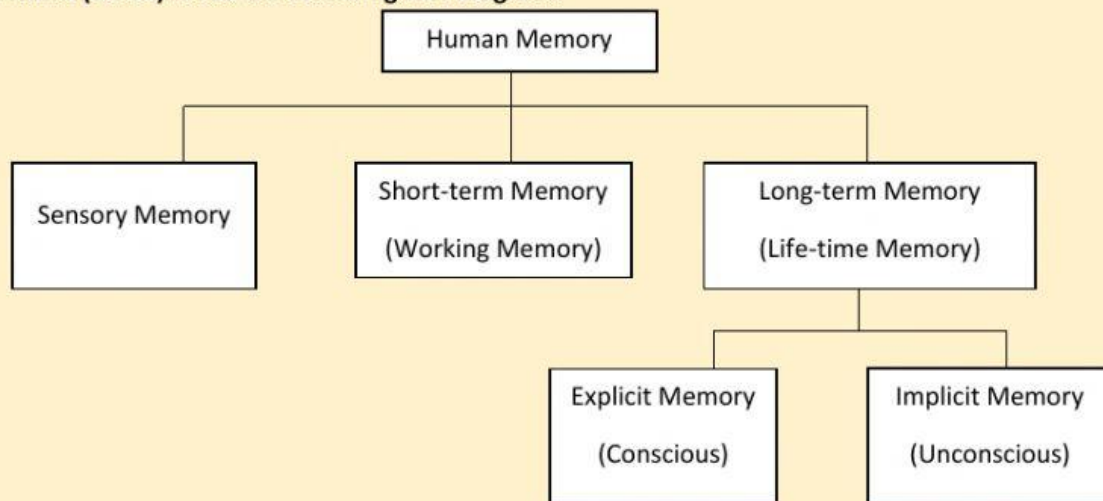
Mrs. Slater : He's out of his senses. (General consternation)
