

HOW TO PROCESS WOOD

1. Join the following tasks to process wood with its description and corresponding image:

Sawing	The logs are transported by road, rail or water to their destination.		
Planing	This happens at the sawmill. A chain of rollers with metal teeth turns and removes the bark.		
Cutting and pruning	The logs are cut into planks that are cut parallel to the axis of the log.		
Removing the bark	The wood is dry under pressure so that it doesn't warp.		
Drying	To make the wood smooth and evenly flat.		
Transport	Trees are cut down with chainsaws and the branches are then cut off
