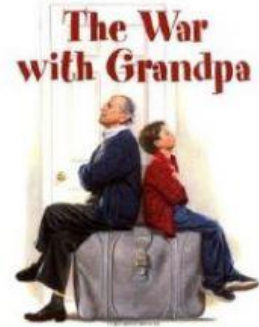


“The War with Grandpa”, by Robert Kimmel Smith
