

EQUIPMENT A WAREHOUSE WORKER SHOULD KNOW

Draw a line from the equipment on the left to the definition on the right

Pallet Rack	Part of the warehouse where trucks load/unload
Fork Lift	Keeps face protected from injury at work
Hand Truck	Uses belts and rollers to move products
Pallet (or Skid)	Used to put products on for storage or shipping
Industrial Scale	Should always be worn to protect your hands
Packing Table	Two wheel device – helps move heavy items
Reach Truck	Lifts employees up high instead of a ladder
Dock	Protects the eyes from flying debris or spills
Conveyor Belt	Helps the workers be seen by others
Hard Hat	Protects the feet (especially toes) from injury
Safety Glasses	Protects the head from falling objects
Steel Toe Shoes	Used to lift and move pallets in warehouse
Face Shield	Measures the weight of items (In or out)
Reflective Vest	Place where products can be packaged
Safety Gloves	Place where pallets are stored in the warehouse
