### How to make an espresso

First, you (1) need (need) good quality beans. Then, the beans (2) are ground (grind) very finely into a powder. Next, the ground beans (3) are placed (place) into a container in the espresso machine. The base of the machine (4) contains (contain) water, and when you (5) heat (heat) the water, it boils and turns into steam. The steam (6) is forced (force) through the coffee by the funnel shape of the container. Finally, the steam condenses at the top of the machine and the liquid (7) falls (fall) back into a container. Machines in daily use (8) should be cleaned (should/clean) regularly to keep the fresh coffee taste.
