Gail: ⁴ I only did one bungee jump, though. I didn't enjoy it at all!

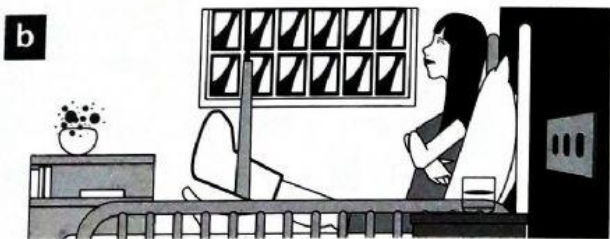
Max: ⁵ It was too scary.
