## Rules for Comparative Adjectives

Comparative Adjectives	Rules	Examples
One syllable	Add <b>er</b>	cleaner
Two syllables ending in -y	Change <b>y</b> to <b>i</b> and add <b>er</b>	busier
Two or more syllables	Use the word <b>more</b>	more active

*Flor Rumayna*

From: Madre de Dios  
Years: 57 years old  
Weight: 76 kg  
High: 1.58 m tall



*Gladys Tejeda*

From: Jauja  
Years: 35 years old  
Weight: 44 kg  
High: 1.55 m tall



*Maju Mantilla*

From: Trujillo  
Years: 36 years old  
Weight: 54 kg  
High: 1.74 m tall
