

## Present Simple

Use present simple to talk about:

daily routines,

likes, dislikes

hobbies.

Example: I take online classes.      My dad works.    I don't like

Use the verbs in brackets to complete the sentence.

Formula: **I** + verb      **You** + verb      **we** + verb      **they** + verb

**I** \_\_\_\_\_ pizza. (like)

**We** usually \_\_\_\_\_ soccer. (play) soccer.

**They** often \_\_\_\_\_ their bikes. (ride)

**You** sometimes \_\_\_\_\_ video games. (play)

**I** rarely \_\_\_\_\_ to the park. (go)

**We** often \_\_\_\_\_ karate. (do)

**They** never \_\_\_\_\_ to music. (listen)

Add an “**s, ies, es**” when you use **he, she and it**.

In general + s	Verbs ending in conson. + y y + ies	Verbs ending in -o, sh, tch, x, ss + es
work → works	study → studies	go → goes
eat → eats	cry → cries	wash → washes
play → plays	try → tries	watch → watches
swim → swims	spy → spies	mix → mixes
write → writes	fly → flies	kiss → kisses

My dad sometimes \_\_\_\_\_ tv. (watch)

My sister \_\_\_\_\_ skateboarding. (go)

My little brother \_\_\_\_\_ to school. (walk)

My mom \_\_\_\_\_ deliciously. (cook)

My cat \_\_\_\_\_ in the garden. (play)
