

But sometimes he goes to work on Saturday and then he feels stressed.

Francoise is from Switzerland. She's a teacher in a school in Geneva. She is at school for 7 hours every day and also works at home in the evenings but she doesn't work at the weekend. Francoise has a lot of friends and they like to have dinner in expensive restaurants. She goes to bed very late on Saturday evenings. Francoise doesn't do sports or go to the gym, but she has two dogs and she takes them for long walks on Sunday afternoons. Once a month she visits her sister and brother-in-law who live in France.
