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| Kulla Raymi (September 21) () | 1. This celebration is known as the ancestral Christmas and it's a religious festival in tribute to the sun that has an enormous cultural and historical value. |
| Mixed-race () | 2. Relating to or typical of shamanism (a form of religion involving a person who is thought to have special powers to influence spirits). |
| Kapak Raymi (December 21) () | 3. Relating to the indigenous people of the Americas. |
| Amerindian () | 4. Celebration of the bounteous provisions from Pacha Mama, or Mother Earth. With the word pawkar meaning blossoming, and raymi meaning a ritual, ceremony or festival, Pawkar Raymi is also referred to as the "Fiesta of the Flowering of the Maize". |
| Inti Raymi (June 21) () | 5. Something that is a part of your history or that remains from an earlier time |
| Customs () | 6. Features belonging to the culture of a particular society, such as traditions, languages, or buildings, that were created in the past and still have historical importance. |
| Shamanistic () | 7. Traditional celebration which represents the beginning of life and exalts women as the ultimate representation of fertility. |
| Heritage () | 8. A combination of groups of people who share the same language, history and characteristics. |
| Pawkar Raymi (March 21) () | 9. Traditional religious ceremony in honor of the god Inti ("sun"). |
| Legacy () | 10. Ways of behaving or beliefs that have been established for a long time. |
