Negative		Questions	
Countable nouns	Uncountable nouns	Countable nouns	Uncountable nouns
There aren't <b>any</b> apples.	There isn't <b>any</b> lemonade.	Are there <b>any</b> oranges?	Is there <b>any</b> cheese?
There aren't <b>any</b> bananas.	There isn't <b>any</b> sugar.	Are there <b>any</b> biscuits?	Is there <b>any</b> ice cream?
There aren't <b>any</b> people.	There isn't <b>any</b> money.	Are there <b>any</b> children?	Is there <b>any</b> water?

In negative sentences and in questions, we use **any** before plural countable nouns and uncountable nouns.
