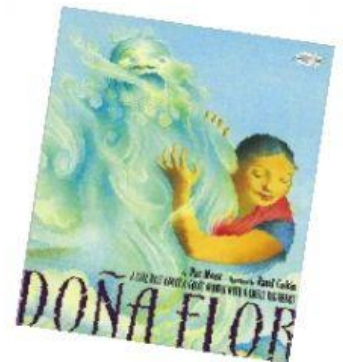
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Exhausted, Flor climbed the tallest and there he found a little puma that wasn't so She saw Pumito was roaring into a long log... that's why the sound was so loud!
