Simple Past Tense

It is used to express:

- An action which happened in the past. e.g. I was at school yesterday.
- Past routines and habits. e.g. She usually walked the dog at night.

- * How to add d or ed?
- the general rule is to add ed at the end of the verb e.g. worked talked watched washed
- If the verb ends in e, add d e.g. lived loved
- If the verb ends in a consonant + y, y changes into i and add ed e.g. try tried cry cried study studied
- If the verb ends in a vowel + y, add ed e.g. play played stay stayed
- If it is a one syllable verb which ends in consonant-vowel-consonant, we repeat the final consonant and add ed e.g. stop stopped
