Rosa always (put) on her school uniform in the morning. She (not/wear) old dresses.	Look! Rosa (not/wear) her school uniform! She (wear) an old dress!
Mary always (have) a healthy breakfast in the morning. She never (eat) chips.	Look! Mary (not/have) her healthy breakfast! She (eat) chips!
Susan always (take) her bag and (go) to school. She (not/stay) at home.	Oh, look! Susan (not/take) her bag! She (not/go) to school! She (stay) at home!
Nancy always (have) classes at ten in the morning. She (not/sleep) at that time.	Now it's ten o'clock but Nancy(not/have) classes. She(get) up.
Rob always (walk) his dog in the park at four in the afternoon. He (not/stay) at home and he (not/read) any books.	It's four in the afternoon but Rob (not/walk) his dog! He (stay) at home and – look! – he (read) a book!
Mr. Happy always (do) his shopping at seven p.m. He (not/watch) TV.	It's seven p.m. but Mr. Happy(not/do) his shopping. He(sit) on the sofa! He(watch) TV!
Mr. Busy always (work) until 11 p.m. He (go) to bed early.	It's only ten in the evening but Mr. Busy (not/work)! He (go) to bed!
